From now onwards, therefore, we do not judge anyone by the standards of the flesh. Even if we did once know Christ in the flesh, that is not how we know him now. And for anyone who is in Christ, there is a new creation; the old creation has gone, and now the new one is here.

And the wind dropped, and all was calm again. Then he said to them, 'Why are you so frightened? How is it that you have no faith?' They were filled with awe and said to one another, 'Who can this be? Even the wind and the sea obey him.'

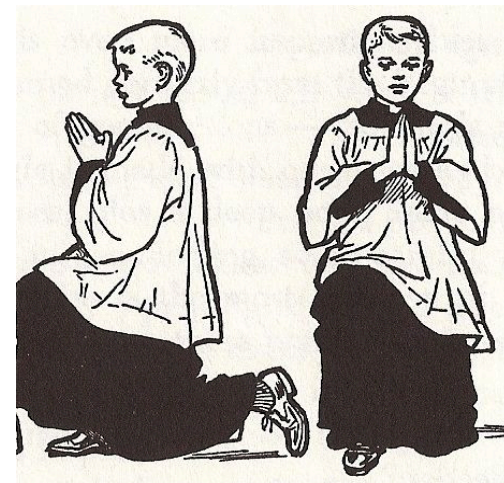

Reverence in Church is very important. Catholics, when entering a Catholic Church, genuflect towards the Blessed Sacrament in the Tabernacle, and genuflect when they pass the Tabernacle and before they leave the Church. (*Those who are unable to*



genuflect bow.) If they are working in the Church and going backwards and forwards, it is enough to genuflect the first and last time, and bow (from the waist) the other times. This is an act of worship and of faith. It comes from the Sacred Scriptures and has been the practise in the Church ever since the Blessed Sacrament has been reserved in the Church. If the Tabernacle is not in the Sanctuary, we still bow when we pass the altar, as the altar is the major symbol of Christ and is holy. Nothing should ever be placed on the altar unless it is to do with the Sacred Liturgy. It must never be used as a table. When we are in Church it is also very important that we are conscious that we are in a sacred place and that Our Lord is silently waiting there for us to impart His grace, love and mercy to us. He loves us completely and always desires our love. (*PS "Genuflect" is a Latin word meaning "bend the knee"*)
